My preferred option is ten making it a more manageable number. the working party's preferred choice based on public feedback – to reduce the number of councilors from 12 to 10 (eight general ward councilors and two Maori ward councilors) – was not adopted.

2nd choice This means that residents who are enrolled on the general electoral roll can elect ten general electoral ward councillors, and residents enrolled on the Māori electoral roll can elect two Māori electoral ward councillors – 12 councillors in total. All councillors would have full voting rights.

I understand that The total amount of remuneration paid to councillors would not reduce if there were fewer councillors. Councillors' remuneration is based on a fixed pool of funds set independently by a government agency, the Remuneration Authority, and does not increase or decrease the number – the total is divided between the number of elected members. Community boards are funded at a targeted rate.

Fewer councillors will ensure better engagement and acountability by all elected members with communities and council staff - more concise information, improved accountability and shorter response and decision times. Elected members must operate as a board of directors and ensure that council staff maintain systems, policies and procedures that reflect the democratic intent and principles of the LGA 2002. Two recent issues have recently occurred where significant decisions have been taken by council staff ahead of the formal, democratic decisionmaking process. (Purchase of land for hotel and rural kerbside recycling). Fewer councillors with more accountability by each is essential to ensure the ball is not dropped in future. The proposal as it stands is simply a watered down version of the pre-1989 arrangement with the added overlay of a seperate Maori ward.

- > Furthermore given the stance of the current government the Maori ward is unlikely to eventuate.
- > Unfortunately to my knowledge there has been no thought given to alternative formal representation methods
- > for Tangata Whenua.

As LGNZ says there is no perfect system of representation. However WDC has taken a strictly prescriptive approach to finding solutions to the problem of what suits us best. Fundamentally this is about our local interpretation of democracy and its future. Some understanding of what democracy means, trends in participation, changes within society, local and worldwide implications are all extremely relevant. Have they been taken into account?

I understand this as a review of our local democracy representation that may not happen again for another six years. How strenuously has engagement been with those that will become entitled to vote for the first time in the next six years? Education about the issues of democracy is key component of LGNZ's thrust but education about the alternatives and the experience we have already witnessed has been devoid in the preparation of the matter here.

I understand we are not obliged to consider the fragmented District-wide ward system (that was used for a time) but why not? We have the history of both. Where is the analysis? Again STV is system that some say provides greater equity for minority segments of society.

Why should that not be considered as part of the mix?

To summarise, the sparse information provided with the Submission form is confusing and contradictory and lacking in solid reasoning (Ref. "Background" and statements on what is not being consulted on). Consequently all this survey can be is an average of the sample group's prejudices. What a lost opportunity...

What seems to be lacking is any thought about the objectives of this exercise. We are supposed to be a UNESCO City of Design. You can interpret design in all sorts of ways but basically it is simply an elegant solution to a complex problem.

Proven analytical design methods have been around for decades and could well bring wider understanding of the problems we face and lead to better creative solutions to boot.


