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## Please Read IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON THE INFRASTRUCTURE BOND

## **Explanation**

- The Whanganui District Council has significant infrastructure assets in its road corridor. Damage to those assets from building works can come at a cost to the ratepayers of the Whanganui District.
- The purpose of the Infrastructure Bond is to encourage the applicant to ensure that the infrastructure assets are not damaged. Further, in the event of damage, the infrastructure bond will ensure that the
- cost of repairing rests with the party responsible for its damage.

  Damage includes but is not limited to the following: damage to footpaths, kerbing and channel, road surface, street furniture, tobies, trees, berms and other Council assets in the road corridor.

  The Infrastructure Bond applies to all building consents (and/or resource consents) for demolition, re-
- moval, relocation and construction of buildings, and structures (including commercial) in the urban zone.

Review of Bond Amount

- Pursuant to a Resolution of the Whanganui District Council (17 June 2008) a builder who is a preferred applicant may apply for an exemption from paying an infrastructure bond on each consent. The resolution states: "That the Chief Executive has delegated authority to waiver the refundable bond amount for builders with multiple consents".
- An application for waiver of the Bond amount can be made on the appropriate form obtainable from the Council building at 101 Guyton Street, Whanganui.
- To find out if you are eligible for a waiver of the bond amount, please talk to a member of the Customer Services team in the first instance.
